Businesses decorated studs incorporating their logos, autographs, inspirational messages, and artwork. They then posed with their creation to become featured as a Stud of the Month. Like Sponsor-a-Stud the calendar sponsors will be invited to our next Habitat home build, prior to installing the sheetrock, so they can meet the future homeowners and see the placement of their customized studs. Stud sponsors leave the event feeling a connection to the house and the family. The family experiences the support of the community.

"We are especially grateful to our presenting sponsors Hard Rock Hotel and Casino – Sioux City, and Seaboard Triumph Foods. Not only did Hard Rock come on as a financial sponsor they lent us the talents of their marketing team and their concert photographer, Britton Hacke.
